GAS EXCLUSION – MODIFIED

This Endorsement Changes the Policy. Please Read It Carefully.

Certain words and phrases in bold font have special meaning as defined below or in the form to which this Endorsement is attached.

The titles of sections or paragraphs listed below should not be considered for purposes of interpreting the intent of this Form; these titles have only been inserted for ease of reading.

This Endorsement is attached to the Commercial General Liability Max Form and is subject to all terms, conditions, limitations and exclusions of such Form.

1. The following exclusion is added to 2. EXCLUSIONS under COVERAGE A – BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY of SECTION 1 – COVERAGES in the Commercial General Liability form:

This insurance does not apply to:

- 2.24. Installation or Removal of Gas Mains and Meters

Bodily injury or property damage arising from:

- 2.24.1. The installation or removal of gas mains, including laterals outside of buildings or other structures that are on the **inlet side of meters**;
- 2.24.2. The installation or removal of, or repair of gas meters.

2. DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Endorsement:

Inlet side of the meter means the connection to the meter to which gas flows from the street mains or pipes, or other supply devices.

All other terms and conditions of the Policy remain unchanged.
