

Fire Department Service Charges (Farm)

If "Fire Department Service Charges" is shown on your coverage summary page, it is agreed that:

Fire department service charges are covered up to the Limit of Insurance specified in the "Declaration Page(s)" in any one occurrence when:

- (a) The "Insured" has assumed such charges by Municipal contract or agreement prior to the loss;
- (b) The Fire department is called to save or protect the insured property from a peril insured against; and
- (c) The insured property is on the premises described in the "Declarations Page".
- (d) The "Insured" becomes legally obligated to pay to protect property from imminent "hostile fire".

Hostile fire means a fire that becomes uncontrollable or breaks out from where it was intended to be.

This coverage is not subject to a deductible.

The limit stated above does not reduce the amount of insurance.

Except as otherwise provided by this endorsement all terms and conditions of this policy remain unchanged.
