EXTENSION OF COVERAGE – ACCIDENTAL POISONING

This Endorsement Changes the Policy. Please Read It Carefully.

Certain words and phrases that appear in bold have special meaning as defined below or in the form to which this Endorsement is attached.

The titles of sections or paragraphs listed below should not be considered for purposes of interpreting the intent of this Endorsement; these titles have only been inserted for ease of reading.

This Endorsement is attached to the Livestock – Named Perils Form, and, except as otherwise provided under this Endorsement, is subject to all terms, conditions, limitations and exclusions of such Form.

Notwithstanding exclusion 2.8. POISONING OF LIVESTOCK under paragraph 2. **EXCLUDED PERILS** or any other contrary provision contained under this Policy, the insurance provided by this Form is extended to cover direct physical loss or direct physical damage caused to **livestock** by accidental poisoning of two animals (**livestock**) or more at the same occurrence. However, this Extension of Coverage does not apply to poisoning of **livestock** previously sick or if such poisoning is caused by medication.

All other terms and conditions of the Policy remain unchanged.
