FOREST AND PRAIRIE FIRE FIGHTING EXPENSE ENDORSEMENT

THIS ENDORSEMENT CHANGES THE POLICY. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY.

It is agreed that:

1. Insurance provided under SECTION I – COVERAGES of the Wrap-Up Liability Form is extended to include the following:

1. INSURING AGREEMENT

We will only pay those sums for forest and prairie firefighting expenses that you become obligated to pay by reason of any applicable federal, provincial, territorial or municipal law, statute, ordinance, rule or regulation for forest or prairie fires occurring in the coverage territory and during the policy period.

2 EXCLUSIONS

The insurance does not apply to any:

- 2.1. Expense or liability assumed by the Insured solely under any contract or agreement, except for forest and prairie firefighting expenses that would have existed in the absence of such contract or agreement;
- 2.2. Action brought against one or more insureds by any other insured with respect to the recovery of forest and prairie firefighting expenses;
- 2.3. Forest and prairie firefighting expenses of others while working on the Insured's behalf where forest and prairie firefighting expenses coverage has been acquired by them and is available; or
- 2.4. Fines or penalty brought against the Insured.

3. LIMIT OF INSURANCE

The Limit of Insurance shown in the Declaration Page(s) for this Endorsement is the most we will pay for all forest and prairie firefighting expenses imposed upon the Insured in one policy period.

4. DEDUCTIBLE

Our obligation to pay on your behalf applies only to the amount of forest and prairie firefighting expenses in excess of any forest and prairie firefighting expenses deductible shown in the Declaration Page(s).

5 OTHER INSURANCE

Coverage provided by this Endorsement will apply in excess of any valid and collectible insurance naming the Insured as an insured, covering forest and prairie firefighting expenses.

2. For the purposes of this Endorsement only, the following definition is added SECTION V - DEFINITIONS of the Wrap-Up Liability Form:

Forest and prairie firefighting expenses means any costs and expenses for controlling and extinguishing forest or prairie fires which the Insured is obligated to pay under the provisions of any applicable federal, provincial, territorial or municipal law, statute, ordinance, rule or regulation.

All other terms, conditions and limitations of this Policy shall remain unchanged.
